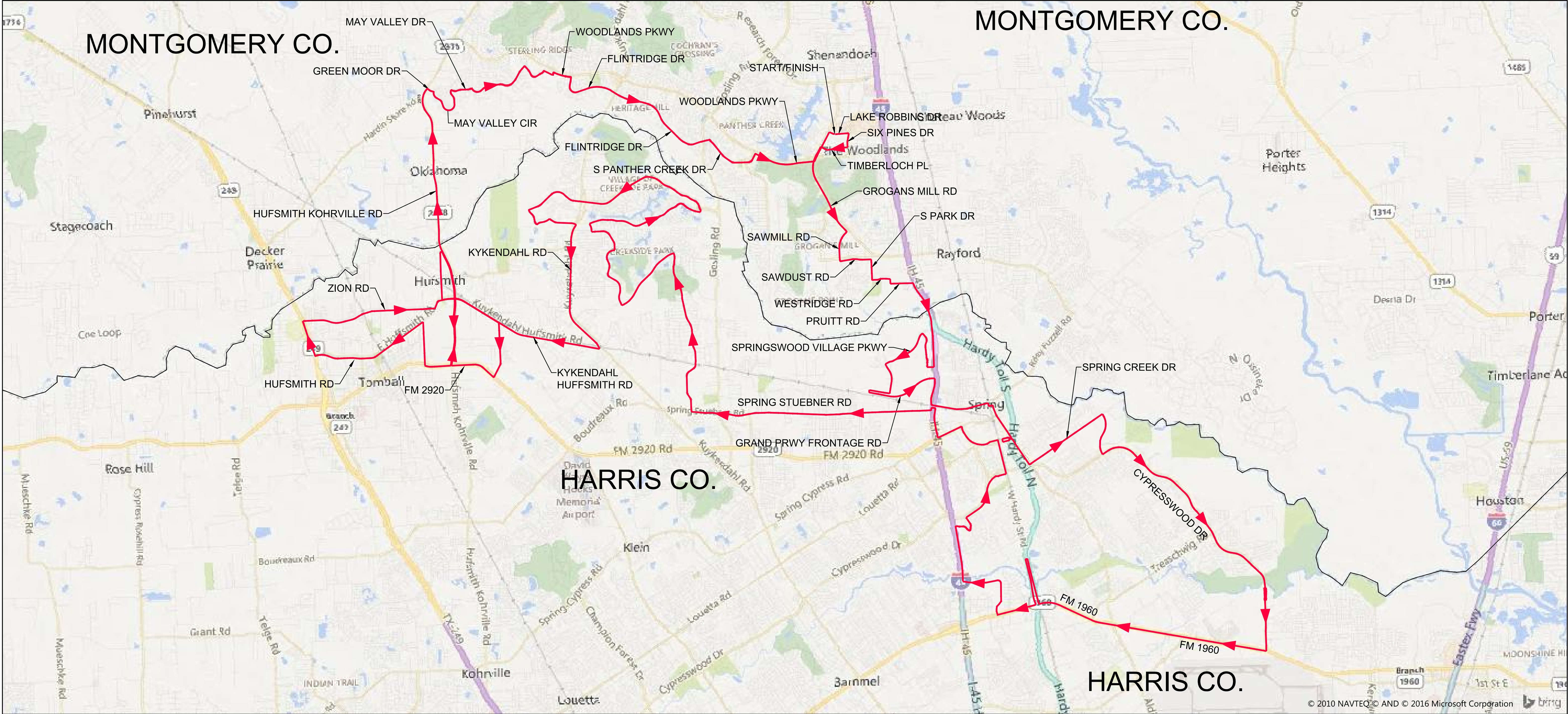

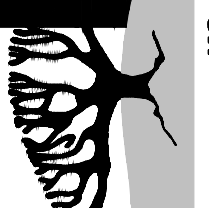

BIKE ROUTE GENERAL LAYOUT

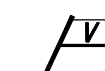

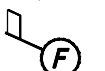

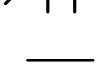
